We and our customers have loved the light weight contemporary pots that we found last vear; there will be more of those, plus some huge pots that are made partially of fiberglass to



weigh significantly less while remaining durable. This classic is 31.5" wide and weighs only 100 lbs.



On the lighter side whimsy-wise, Yoga Cat is a musthave. The Yoga Cat is one of the hundred new cast stone pieces introduced, many of which were designed by Eddie Martinez, their in-house sculptor the who carved original from a block of plaster; Eddie has been creating artful

cast stone pieces at Campania for 25 years.!

New and noteworthy applies to glazed terra cotta pieces as well. We chose many large sets of containers, garden seats, hose storage pots, and a handful of small cachepots. We were able to choose from more than 150 new pieces in 14 new glaze colors! They are displayed on their showroom floor with a rainbow-like effect, making it hard to decide.

A favorite is Eau de Nil, a soft but bright spring green that will flatter any flowers you plant in it! We are eager to try these pots among outdoor pillows and rugs to make luscious patio vignettes.





Every garden needs a touch of black. "Galaxy", is a smashing new glaze black infused with little It will sparkles. coordinate nicely with many other containers and plants, from white to black foliage.

This Edo jar, one of our favorites, in one of our favorite Celadon glazes, Pearl, stands on its own as a focal point, or it could hold a special architectural plant. Its softly pearlized glaze and gently rounded shape make it an elegant piece.




We love these hose pots; they are an attractive, safe, and durable way to store and camouflage ugly garden hoses.
