GOOD DESIGN WITH CONTAINERS

We have been writing about container gardening for 18 years. We could write a book. You might think the subject would eventually bore us, but not so. This growing season we are more excited than ever about the prospect of using containers in new ways.

For instance, customers come in looking for a solution to their problem areas where nothing will grow. You yourself may have such an area: beneath a tree, a hot west-facing patio, a boring balcony. Containers solve the problem of being unable to grow something in the ground in a troublesome location. Place a container in any of these situations for instant ideal growing conditions: color, form, beauty—instant garden.

Rethink what you grow; the beauty and value of plants is not just in blossoms, but in form, leaf texture, and color. A wise garden designer once said "Great containers have everything to do with good design." With a little forethought, good design actually can be simple.



Once you have selected your pots from Wilshire Garden Market according to your patio or home design style and color scheme, go beyond traditional annuals. Try using plants with no blooms: ferns, shrubs (nandina, boxwood, yew, or rose), dwarf trees,

ennials, ground cover, or herbs. Pay attention to the nuances of color and form between the container and your plant material, and how they relate to your home and outdoor furnishings. When all aspects relate well, the results are superb.

If you use an unplanted container as a focal point,



consider its visual relationship to nearby plants. Coordinate texture, color, and design of the container with the texture, color, and growth habit of surrounding plants to create a harmonious vignette.

Soon this dappled willow will grow to encompass the large container; portions of its foliage are the color of the pale terra cotta pot.

Lifestyle also plays a role in the selection of

containers and plant material. Sometimes, in addition to beauty, ease and durability are key factors in selecting containers and plants. Frequent travelers will benefit



from large containers planted with durable evergreens, piped for regularly scheduled watering.

MAY TO DO LIST

- Sow seeds of warm-season annuals.
- Divide and move perennials if needed.
- Gently clean up flower beds being careful not to disturb new plants.
- Top dress with organic fertilizer and apply compost and mulch. No volcano mulching around woody trunks. Start 2 – 3 inches away. No huge chips and no colored mulch please.
- Edge beds in a clean, defined line.
- When potting plants, consider using something different, such as ferns and hostas.
- Houseplants can go outdoors n bright light areas only after nighttime temperatures are above 50 degrees.
- Begin gently fertilizing houseplants. Remember to always water before fertilizing.
