- Sow seeds of hardy spring annuals
- Plant cool season vegetable seedlings.
- Order summer bulbs: lilies, etc.

When the snow melts, go "rooting around" in your garden to see what is sprouting. Leave mulch on the ground and leave the tops of dormant perennials for insulation.


